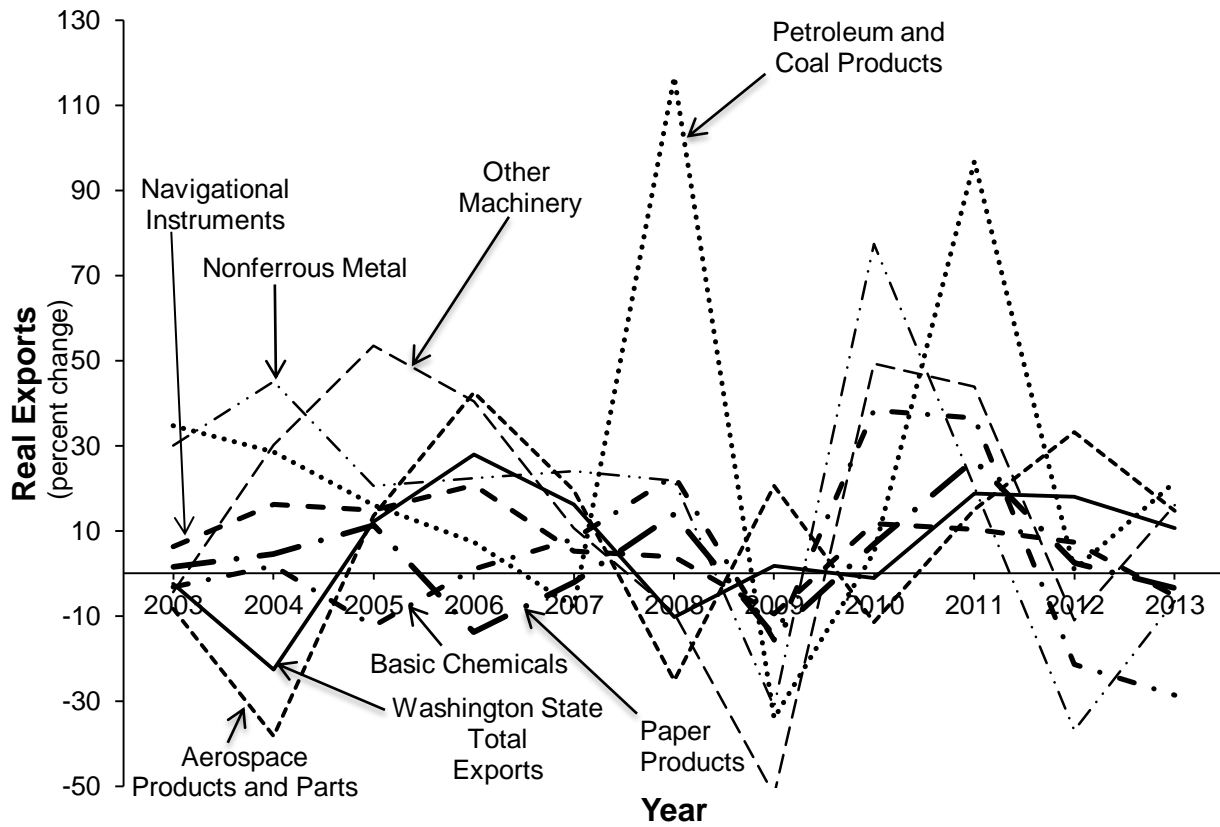


**Graph 3: Inflation-Adjusted Exports for Seven Washington State Industries to the World as Year-to-Year Percent Changes**
