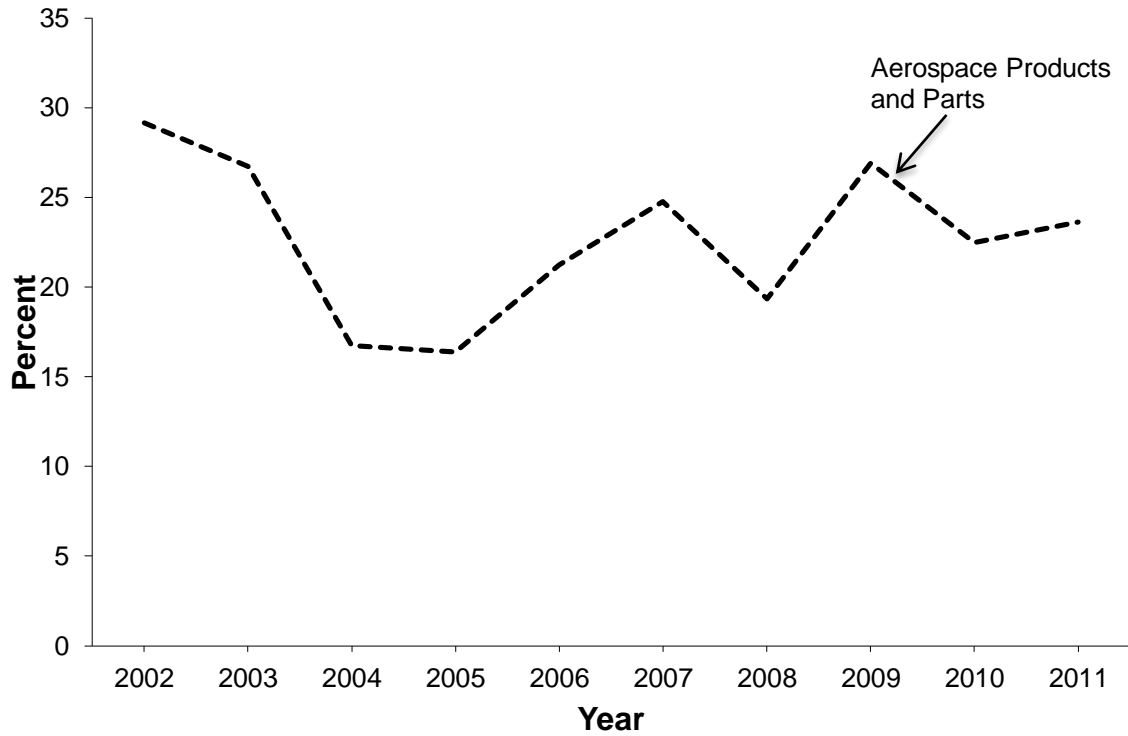


Graph 6: Percent of Washington State Total Shipments Exported to the World for Aerospace Products and Parts by Year
